What You Get

- Turflux On-Boarding documents detailing the information needed for us to create the best maps for your future GPS spraying.
- Mapping of your initial primary spray boundaries by experienced Turflux personnel (Greens – Approaches – Fairways – Tees)
 - Includes planning and preparation discussion
 - Based on the topography of your property and the complexity of your spray areas we may map additional Fields (spray zones or “cut-out” areas)
- Your maps will be edited to meet our Turflux spray boundary standards for clean borders and defined transitions between Fields (spray zones)
- A Rough Map will be created using software by first drawing a border around your property. All fine turf and mapped “cut-out” areas will be cut out giving you a detailed spray map to use for a Rough Spray application.
- After final editing, your maps will be loaded into your sprayer(s)
- A copy of your sprayer maps will be exported to your on-line Trimble account
 - Allowing for easy viewing on your computer or iPad, and
 - The ability to see the acreage of your individual boundaries

What We Need from You

- Complete the ‘Customer Spray Form’ so we can name the spray zones with the names you and your staff refer to when spraying
- Provide name and cell phone number of on-site point person (or people)
- Spend some initial planning time with us to make sure your final mapped areas work best for the way you spray
- Have any staff members, interested in learning “how to” map, review the Mapping Best Practices document and setup the Mobile Manager and TerraFlex apps on their phone or iPad (important if you plan to buy or rent a DA2 Mapping Kit)
- Two golf carts, or utility carts, for us to use while mapping. The best carts for us would include:
 - Electric (fully charged) so we can easily transport during golf
 - Carts with good power, good brakes, and a good turning radius
 - Carts with “friendly” turf tires
 - Golf Carts work well – be sure GPS restrictions are turned off



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What You Can Add

Turflux has always provided a mapping service as part of our system conversions. We continue to lead with the most innovative mapping techniques, now including a Handheld “survey quality” mapping unit. The same equipment we use to make your maps is available for purchase or rent for customers interested in making additional detailed mapping of spray areas or to map other features on your course, with sub-inch accuracy, such as drain lines, irrigation pipe, valve boxes, and many other features.

- **DA2 Handheld Kit – Purchase** **\$3,278**
 - Includes a catalyst DA2 Antenna with handle, 2 batteries, one year subscription for TerraFlex Core for data retrieval, 50 hours of prepaid correction streaming for sub-inch accuracy, and 8 hours of map editing time
 - Streaming and editing hours do not expire
 - After first year, TerraFlex Core subscriptions can be purchased, as needed, on a monthly basis for \$85/month (or \$575 annually) and streaming and editing hours will be pre-billed on 10- and 5-hour increments (based on need)
- **DA2 Handheld Kit – Rental Options** **(One Week* - \$662) (Two Weeks* - \$900)**
 - Use one of our kits (based on availability) and piggyback on the Turflux TerraFlex data retrieval plan
 - One-week rental includes 16 hours of streaming and 4 hours of map editing
 - Two-week rental includes 25 hours of streaming and 5 hours of map editing
