

Customer Spray Zone Worksheet

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Zone / Field	Customer Named Zones (or <i>New Name</i>)	Turflux definition
Primary Spray Zones		Included with Turflux Conversion
Greens		Greens as defined by your typical "Greens Spray"
Approaches		Note here if you have No Approaches or if they are sprayed on their own, or sprayed with Greens or with Fairways. We will map them accordingly.
Fairways		If fairways are typically sprayed with Intermediate Rough you may wish to map both Fairways and Fairways & IR to give you spray options later. Note if you have No Intermediate Rough.
Tees		Tees are typically mapped with a ~ 12" buffer. If you also spray larger tee areas like Tee Surrounds or Tee Box (e.g. inside fescue), add them below
Additional Spray Zones		Based on the topography of your property and the complexity of your spray areas we will typically have time to map an additional 2 or 3 spray zones to fit in with your typical spray applications
GreenTops		Usually add one of these options as a variation to your typical "Greens Spray". Typically GreenTops for the green height only (usually for cool season PGR apps), or Greens & Collars if your "Greens Spray" is for greens height turf only.
Greens and Collars		
Fairways and IR		Fairways with Intermediate Rough can be mapped separately from Fairways to give you spray options later.
Tees Other		Same as Tees, but for different spray program, like different species of grass.
Tees Surround		Tees with surrounding area. For example mapping to the edge of nearby Natives, cart paths, or and tree line.
Walk Paths		Courtesy walking paths from tee to fairway.

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Rough		This area is typically produced during map editing, but some areas can be mapped if external map borders are important, such as rough internal to fine turf like fairways.
Natives		Fescue or Native area that might be sprayed separately, but will definitely be removed from your final Rough map.
Other		To use if we come across an area to map and are not sure which zone to add it to.
When mapping Cut-Out zones, think of it as the area you do not want to spray when spraying next to it.		
Cut Out Zones		These are mapped to use in editing to remove, or cut out, from actual spray zones (like Fairways, and/or Rough)
Bunkers		This is a Cut-Out, so map it as the actual bunker plus any area that is only sprayed with a spray gun or walk boom. This zone will be cut out of your Rough map.
Pavement		Parking lots, cart paths, buildings, etc. (This is an area typically done by the customer with a rented or purchased mapping kit, if they want a very detailed Rough Map)
Water		No spray water areas such as streams, ponds, etc. (This is an area typically done by the customer with a rented or purchased mapping kit, if they want a very detailed Rough Map)
